The Colorado Pollinator Summit brings together people from different walks of life, including community members, teachers, artists, gardeners, organizers, and researchers to share ideas and perspectives to work together and support one another to protect our natural world and our communities through our shared love of pollinators.

You are invited to submit your idea for a 45-to-60 minute presentation, panel discussion, music or dance performance, or demonstration for the 9th annual Colorado Pollinator Summit, which will be held on Monday, November 18th, 2024 at Denver Botanic Gardens.

The venue is an auditorium that seats around 200, with a small stage that includes a large screen that can display slides or videos. **The due date to submit your presentation idea is May 31, 2024.** Submissions will be reviewed by a team that includes justice and environmental community advocates, who will collectively make the decision to offer a candidate the invitation to present at the summit. All submissions will be considered. You will be informed by June 15, 2024 if you are chosen to present.

- ✓ Working title for your presentation
- ✓ The format for your presentation (talk, panel, performance or demonstration) and the person or people who will be presenting
- ✓ A brief summary/description of your idea, including what you'd like to convey to the summit audience from your presentation
- ✓ Will you need support for travel and lodging expenses? If so, please let us know what you'll need.
- ✓ If your presentation will be in a language other than English, please let us know if you need an interpreter
- ✓ Are there any other accommodations that you anticipate? If so, please tell us what you'll need.
